CAMP RULES

CHECK-IN/OUT: RV site check-in is 1:00pm. Cabin check-in is 3:00pm. Check-out is 11:00am. No check-ins after 7:00 unless prior arrangements have been made.

VISITORS: Parking on site is very limited. If you wish to park in the campground there is a \$10.00 fee per vehicle. Visitors must leave by 10:00pm. Registered guests are responsible for their visitors.

CHILDREN: Please ensure that children are supervised at all times.

SPEED LIMIT: Please observe the 10km/h speed limit for the safety of everyone.

SMOKING AND ALCOHOL: Smoking and alcohol consumption is only permitted within your individual campsites.

QUIET HOURS: Quiet hours are from 11:00pm to 8:00am. No excessive noise at any time. No generators please.

MINIMUM AGE: The minimum age to rent a campsite is 21 years old. Minor children must not be left on-site without a responsible adult.

TRASH/RECYCLING: Please take trash to designated bins located on campground map.

VEHICLES: One camper unit and one vehicle per site. Extra vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. All powered vehicles (gas/electric) must be licensed.

CAMPFIRES: Campfires are permitted between the hours of 8:00am and 11:00pm (pending fire bans). Fires must be kept small using clean wood only and contained in the fire rings provided.

SWIMMING POOL: The swimming pool is open between the hours of 10am - Dusk, May - September. There is no lifeguard on duty. Children under the age of 10 must be supervised by an adult. Swim at your own risk.

PETS: Pets must be on a leash (max 5 feet) at all times (cats included) and must not be left unattended. Pet fee per day is \$2.00. Maximum two pets per site. Please pick up after your pets. Pet waste bins are located throughout the campground. Any pet showing signs of aggression may lead to the termination of the licence to occupy.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

- + Maintain a 2-meter distance from each other.
- + Limit gatherings to a max. of 6.
- + Keep everyone safe by wearing a mask.
- + If you have been out of the province or country, and/or you have flu-like symptoms, please report to Check-in.
- + Reduce direct interaction with staff by registering online, emailing, texting, or phoning.
- + No drive-ins permitted, all sites need to register online.

All facilities are being cleaned as per COVID-19 regulations. These increased measures include: increased cleaning, sanitation of high touch areas and the continued closing of some facilities/amenities.
